

EDJAMI RULES AND REGULATIONS

- By-laws of the Local Council regarding noise shall be adhered to and the environment and general area must be preserved and kept in good condition.
- No loud music, shouting, singing or playing music on any instrument or radio is allowed.
- Most people who reside in Marloth Park or visit on vacation come to enjoy the animals, the bush and its natural environment as well as the peaceful ambiance of the park.
- Zero Tolerance disrespecting the above will be allowed and you will be evicted and asked to leave the Park immediately.
- Please do not collect firewood in the bush. Fire wood, charcoal, blitz and ice can be bought at shops close by.
- Please don't throw any foreign objects into the toilet as the house makes use of a septic tank system and can cause blockage.
- Close all kitchen windows and doors as monkeys and baboons do a lot of damage and you will be charged accordingly
- Please report any breakages.
- Please make sure all doors are locked on departure and keys be returned to key box.
- No bathroom towels or blankets are to be used at swimming pool.
- Kitchen is fully equipped with gas stove and oven.
- Be careful not to walk around after sunset as our resident lions, leopards and hyenas are quite active in the park (18h00 -06h00).
- Check out time : Not later than 10h00 or pre-arranged.
- Smoking inside the house is strictly prohibited.
- Please note local by-laws prohibit the use of spotlights.
- It is an offence to remove any animals and plants from Marloth Park. There is a fine/penalty implemented if caught.
- Outdoor Furniture chair covers are stored inside the house.
- Please ensure it is placed inside after use. Please ensure all lights, aircons are switched off.
- Please do not leave dishes in the sink as the cleaning services does not do dishes.
- There will be a charge of R150 if dirty dishes are left.
- Please ensure that all waste is placed in a black bag and it must be placed in the allocated area outside.
- Please do not move the indoor furniture around or take it outside.
- Traffic officers are in Marloth Park to enforce the speed limit on the roads.

EDJAMI GUEST INFORMATION PACK

ARRIVAL

- Check in: 14h00 - 20h00 Late check-in by prior arrangement only.
- Check out: 10h00
- Collect the key inside the key box
- Please remember to pack food away and keep doors and windows of cars closed at all times. Make sure the house doors and windows are closed when you are not at home.
- Please note we are located in a remote area in the bush approximately 5 hours drive from Johannesburg and travelling time to the lodge can be lengthy so preparation
- Self catering at Edjami, there is a braai and boma with a full kitchen.

WEATHER

- Dry season - May to September - Winter
- There is virtually no rainfall during the whole winter and humidity is very low. Animals are attracted to permanent water sources as water becomes scarce in the bush.
- May - This is a transitional month and marks the end of summer. Temperatures are cooling down to typically 12°C/54°F in the morning and 27°C/81°F in the afternoon.
- June, July & August - Morning game drives in open vehicles will be cold, so it's advised to pack warm winter clothing.
- The average morning temperature is 9°C/48°F. Afternoons will be pleasant with temperatures around 26°C/79°F and cloudless skies.
- September - The heat gradually builds to about 29°C/84°F in the afternoons and the first rains bring relief from very dry conditions. Mornings are less cold with temperatures around 14°C/57°F.
- Wet seasons - October to April - Summer
- It can be uncomfortably hot and humid in summer. Peak temperatures frequently reach well over 40°C/104°F, but
- average daytime temperatures go up to 32°C/90°F with high humidity. It seldom rains all day, but the pattern is afternoon storms.
- October & November - It gets warmer and starts to rain more often, mostly in the afternoons. Temperatures are between 18°C/64°F in the morning and 31°C/88°F in the afternoon.
- December, January & February - These are the wettest and hottest months, characterized by torrential downpours in the afternoon and high humidity. Afternoon temperatures are usually around 32°C/90°F but can soar up to an unbearable 40°C/104°F.
- March & April - Rainfall will decrease and it slowly gets colder. This continues in April, which has lovely clear weather and few clouds. The nights get a bit colder but are still pleasant at about 16°C/61°F. Daytime temperatures are around 30°C/86°F and humidity drops in April, making this a very pleasant month.

MALARIA

- We are located in a malaria area and prevention is better than cure so please visit your doctor to ask for his recommendation on malaria prophylaxis. The risk is greater in the summer months.

ACTIVITIES

- Marloth Park game drives are available on request. Please enquire when reserving your accommodation as prior notice is required in order to secure the guides. A 50% deposit is required on bookings.

KRUGER PARK SELF DRIVES
